KZMU adds News at Noon



Spring. It's a season of hopefulness, a time of new beginnings. That's what's going on at KZMU 90.1 & 106.7 FM. As we prepare for another Radiothon, the station's

primary means of financial support. We hope for your generosity. And this year, we ask you to join us on a new adventure: KZMU News.

Moab has other news media and we're grateful for their work. We plan to partner with local and regional media as we grow our public affairs programming. We also believe that community radio can offer a unique perspective and immediacy to the events that are shaping and altering our lives. Moab is bursting with new construction and new businesses and new people. Our natural environment receives much of the impact, but the area's growth has an effect on the community's health, political choices, and on our cultural lives as well. KZMU will offer a daily newscast to illuminate our shared experience with the intimacy only live radio can provide.

Over the last quarter century, under the direction of former Program Director Christy Williams Dunton, KZMU offered many opportunities for public affairs programming, with a special focus on nonprofit activities and local politics. With Christy's transition to the Museum of Moab, KZMU has hired Molly Marcello as News and Public Affairs Director. Molly worked as a reporter for The Times-Independent for over three years. Hosted by Molly, KZMU News debuts at noon on KZMU's 26th birthday, April 2nd.

By adding a daily newscast to the smorgasbord of music programmed by local DJs, KZMU hopes to increase its value to the Moab community. We hope you'll listen to the KZMU News, starting on April 2nd and heard at noon Monday through Friday.

And Krank Ze Music Up! KZMU's diversity of programmers is reflected in the music that's played on KZMU. With ages ranging from early teens to mid 70s our DJs play everything from straight-ahead jazz and Hillbilly country to mainstream pop and indie, with a little mid-century swing, lots of folk, and a taste of hip hop. KZMU's DJs play from the bottomless stacks of CDs at the station,

both new releases and oldies, and many folks bring their own personal music collections to share with listeners. When you tune in to KZMU you can trust that you won't hear the same ten songs every hour, instead you'll hear a true slice of Moab.

This past year KZMU launched the KZMU Radio Club,



a collaboration with the Beacon After School Program, offering middle school students opportunities to try out various radio skills. The students hosted an hour of programming with teacher Josie Kovash, and performed a radio play with sound effects they recorded. Hear the broadcast on kzmu.org under Youth Projects. Our annual radio play, Beautiful Radiant Things, featuring a cast and crew of more than 20 talented Moabites, was our most ambitious and successful so far and is currently posted at kzmu.org.
