Quilters' Patchwork Celebrates Seasonal Cycles

The 23rd Annual Delicate Stitches Quilt Guild Show displays a variety of themed quilts in the South Gallery of the Moab Museum through August 17, 2024. Join us for the FREE public opening on Friday, August 2nd during the Moab Arts "Art Walk" to view the Quilt Show.

This year's theme, Seasons, allows quilters to interpret the theme, whether viewed as calendar or personal seasons. Quilters use a variety of techniques and styles showcasing the personalities of the participants. Vote for your favorite quilts and visit with quilters during the August Art Walk.

This year, the Show presents 29 individual pieces from 12 different artists, including 5 "encore" quilts, which they have shown in previous years but fit into the Seasons theme.

Share your stories related to seasons and local plants with Annie Dalton during Art Walk, who is currently serving as the Community Artist in the Park for the four parks in the Southeast Utah Group. Dalton is gathering stories related to native plants, their uses, and relationships to seasonal traditions folks have,



using them as part of her creative work within the parks. If you have any stories to share, pull up a chair and join Dalton during Art Walk to record a story.

To find the Quilt Guild's work following the Show, quilters will again present their work in 2026 at the bi-annual Quilting in the Red Rocks Show.
