

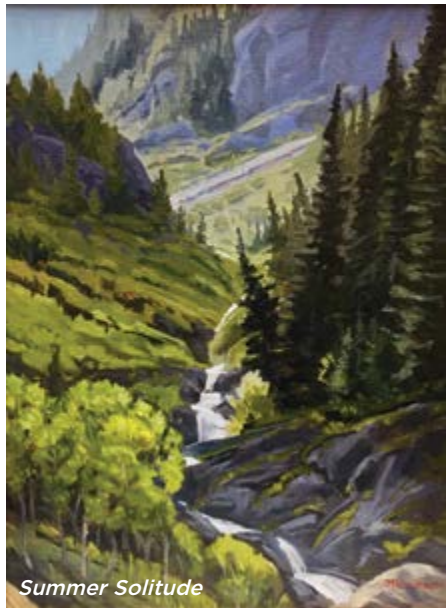
Moab Artwalk Happenings
