

Grounding is a compilation of mixed media works, bones, feathers, and other found natural ephemera created and gathered by Moab-based illustrator Pine Bones.

The displayed works and objects are the result of extreme isolation created by the pandemic, during which time the artist delved completely into their creative work. Images such as moons, bones, feathers, stones and wildlife are recurring motifs within their works. Many of the objects are based on ones the artist has gathered themselves. Incorporating these objects into their personal illustrations, they create a dialogue between themselves and the natural spaces they encountered, dwelled in or called home between March 2020 and April 2022.



View a variety of fine art and handmade crafts; enjoy refreshments and mingle with local and visiting artists. Most exhibits run for a month or more so feel free to stop in anytime at participating locations!
